Latest two years' tax returns; preferably for years 2015 & 2016 including Schedules C and E, if applicable, from parent(s), and from the student, if filed. Both the FAFSA and tax return components are referred to an outside agent for assessment of financial need and are not reviewed by the scholarship committee. FAFSA and tax information is for the exclusive use of the independent analyst and is <u>strictly confidential</u> .			

After the initial review of applications by the committee, select candidates will be notified of the date and time of the mandatory interview with the selection committee. The interview will take place in April. Once the selection process has been completed, each candidate will be notified of the committee's decision regarding her application.

All winners will attend the College Woman's Club Annual Scholarship Dinner and Awards Ceremony to be held at 6:00 p.m., Tuesday, May 23, 2016 at the Echo Lake Country Club. Recipients will be formally honored at that time. In addition, parents or guardians of honorees are invited to attend the awards presentations held immediately following the dinner.
